### **CODE OF ETHICS**

I have read and agreed to abide by the BCSP Code of Ethics.

### **NON-DISCLOSURE AND THEFT OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY**

I will not disclose any portion of a BCSP examination by any means. I will not attempt to leave the testing computer with any information which in any way relates to the content of the examination. If I disclose any portion of a BCSP examination by any means, or if I leave or attempt to leave the testing computer with any written or electronically-recorded examination-related information, BCSP may revoke any BCSP certification I hold, terminate my opportunity to pursue a BCSP certification, or take such other or further action as is deemed appropriate.

I will not knowingly receive any portion of a BCSP examination by any means outside of a securely delivered examination. If I am approached by or become aware of anyone purporting to have BCSP examination content, I will report said individual or organization to BCSP immediately. BCSP may revoke any BCSP certification, terminate opportunities to pursue a BCSP certification, or take such other or further action as is deemed appropriate against anyone who willfully obtains, seeks to obtain, or shares BCSP examination content disclosed by others.

### **EXAMINATION SECURITY**

For the duration of any BCSP examination (i.e., while the examination clock is running, including all break periods), I will not:

- Leave the building.
- Consult verbally, electronically, or in writing with any person other than the proctor or test administrator.
- Consult any written or electronic references.
- Leave the computer, except to take an approved break within the building.

Several security and surveillance procedures are in place during administration of an examination. Proctors and test administrators formally document and report all irregularities to BCSP, and BCSP evaluates each irregularity to determine appropriate actions. Depending on the irregularity, BCSP may invalidate an examination or take additional disciplinary actions against test takers for violating BCSP or Pearson VUE security procedures.
